Price Tag has been featured in several films: Pitch Perfect, a film about collegiate competitive a cappella; Chicken Little, an animated film adaptation of the classic story about the sky falling; and Happy Feet 2, an animated film about the son of a tap-dancing penguin and his journey of self-discovery.

#### **MOVE**

From Dream Girls, 2006 Henry Krieger and Tom Eyen Trio: Anna Black, Natalie Palazzo and Sarah Walker

From the film Dream Girls, based on the hit Broadway musical, Move is performed by the aspiring soul singer trio Effie (Jennifer Hudson), Deena (Beyoncé Knowles) and Lorrell (Anika Noni Rose) in a singing contest which leaves the competition in the dust.

#### LISTEN

Also from Dream Girls, "Listen" is a power ballad originally performed by Deena (Beyoncé Knowles). Deena, through the strategic manuevering of her manager and husband, has achieved the pinnacle of stardom: singer, actress and model. In this song she exerts her desire to be independent from her overcontrolling husband.

Suddenly was written by the original composers of the stage production specifically for the film Les Misérables. Jean Val Jean (Hugh Jackman), the main protagonist, sings this song as he contemplates the wonder of suddenly becoming a father figure to young Cosette.

#### TOUCH THE SKY

Touch The Sky, from Disney/Pixar's Brave, tells the story of Merida, an impetuous red-haired princess determined to forge her own path. This wild and carefree song personifies Merida's love for adventure and independence.

You'll Be In My Heart, composed by superstar Phil Collins, is the feature song to the Disney animated film Tarzan.

Written and performed by Grammy-award winner Bruno Mars, Count On Me was featured in A Turtle's Tale: Sammy's Adventure, a Belgian animated film chronicled the life of a sea turtle named Sammy.

#### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

From Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban, 2004 Arr Teena Chin | Chorale

Double Trouble was originally written by master film composer John Williams, for Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban." The lyrics come from William Shakespeare's Macbeth, Act IV Scene I, when Mac-





beth returns to the witches' cave to learn more of his future. In *Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban*, the Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry Frog Choir sings this song at the welcoming feast of Harry Potter's third term at Hogwarts.

#### **HEDWIG'S THEME**

Composed by John Williams, *Hedwig's Theme* is named after Harry Potter's pet snowy owl, Hedwig. This musical theme has been repeated in all 8 of the Harry Potter films, even when other composers wrote those scores. This leitmotif (a recurring melodic phrase) has often been labeled as the theme song for the entire series.

Originally composed and peformed by the Top Notes in 1961, this song has been covered by many bands, including The Isley Brothers, The Beatles, The Mamas & the Papas, The Tremeloes and The Who. In Ferris Bueller's Day Off, Ferris, while skipping school with his girlfriend and best friend, commandeers a float in a parade and inspires the entire parade to "twist and shout."

#### SOMEWHERE ONLY WE KNOW

Performed and composed by English alternative rock band Keane, this song was featured in the 2009 romantic comedy *He's Just Not That Into You*, a film that follows nine people in Baltimore as they deal with their romantic problems.

#### **EYE OF THE TIGER**

Written and performed by American rock band Survivor, *Eye of the Tiger* is the theme song for *Rocky III*, the third film in the franchise starring 1980s boxer Rocky Balboa (Sylvester Stallone) and James "Clubber" Lang (Mr. T.). This song has been voted VH1's 63rd greatest hard rock song.

#### THEME FROM SCHINDLER'S LIST

Schindler's List is the story of a German businessman that saves the lives of over a thousand Polish-Jewish refugees during the Holocaust. The theme to the film is composed by John Williams.

This derivative is written by Chris Tomlin, an American contemporary Christian musician.

Set and filmed in India, the film recounts the story of former street child Jamal Malik who appears on the Indian version of the game show Who Wants to Be a Millionaire?

### MICHELLE PEDERSEN

Michelle Pedersen is the Associate Director of Music at The Cathedral of the Rockies, just finished her first year as instructor of secondary choirs at North Star Charter School in Eagle, and teaches private voice.

Pedersen is the former director of choirs at Howard St. Charter School in Salem, OR, a middle school with a student body of 155, 135 of whom were in her choirs. She concurrently worked as the Director of Choral Music at First Congregational Church of Salem, and as an adjunct voice instructor at Oregon State University.

Pedersen has degrees in Vocal Performance and Music Education from OSU, where she has been a featured soloist in Oregon, Costa Rica, China, Canada, and Taiwan.

Pedersen is a flexible and polished performer, comfortably singing classical and contemporary styles. She has recently played Mabel (*The Pirates of Penzance*), Susannah (*Le Nozze di Figaro*), Adelaide in (*Guys and Dolls*), Gertrude McFuzz (*Seussical the Musical*), a member of the Angel City 4 (*City of Angels*), Mimi Marquez (*Rent*), and Olive Ostravosky (*25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*).

Pedersen is presenting a summer musical theater workshop for first through eighth graders called IMPACT. Workshops are July 15-20 with two performances on July 20 and July 21.
